ROAD REPORT:

Mowing continues

Received pipe order

Received triaxle of cold patch

Spread 2500' of 2A on Greeley Road and graded

Athey'd and broomed all of Jackson Road, Oakdale Road, Park Road by Park Farm. Currently working on Catholic Church Road

Completely tore up and worked Jackson Road and Blair Road

Spread straight dust control on Jackson Road

Ordered and received one pallet of dust control

Mixing dust control with water on Bottom, Blair, Cathers Run, McCutcheon, Lowers and Howe Roads

Bought 550 gal tank and fittings for dust control

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. Update on Mill Run Bridge Project. Final design of the project is essentially complete and all the bid documents that were requested have been provided.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. At the last Regular Meeting a resident suggested putting up horse and buggy signs up for everyone's safety. The Supervisors agreed that signs should be placed. Three signs were ordered and will be installed once they arrive.

2. The supervisors have received complaints from residents regarding the condition of the back portion of the township's yard. The occupant of the bordering property has been contacted numerous times and has failed to remove the items that have been placed on the township's property. Chairman Greeley spoke with the owner of

the property and was told that they are working on it. The supervisors will review this situation at the next meeting on September 8th, 2025, to determine if any further steps should be taken.

3. The Director of Economic Development submitted the Multimodal Grant for the resurfacing of O'Donnell Road.

OTHER SUPERVISOR COMMENTS OR CONCERNS:

1. The supervisors discussed the plans for work on McManigle Road. The recommendation is to repair the sections that are in decent shape and patch them where necessary. Other sections will be worked by the road crew and go back to dirt.

2. Chairman Greeley will be attending the commissioner's meeting on August 12, 2025, to address some resident's concerns regarding tax assessment.

Supervisor Raybuck made a motion to adjourn at 5:07 PM. The motion was seconded by Chairman Greeley. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
