UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. The Sewage Enforcement Officer has received approval from the DEP to issue sewage permits in the Hanley Tract Subdivision.
2. In regards to the proposed Dollar General: The Township was notified by the DEP that they will publish notice of the draft Individual NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Permit for Discharges of Stormwater Associated with Construction Activities in the Pennsylvania Bulletin in the near future. There will be a 30-day public comment period (which may be extended by 15 days at the DEP's discretion). The DEP will consider any comments received and make a decision on whether to issue a final permit.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Comcast has notified the Township of rate increases and service availability for Xfinity customers effective December 20, 2025.

2. The Township received a low bid of \$31,000.00 for the construction of a 40 x 60 pole building from Eli Mast. Construction should begin on December 10, 2025 weather permitting.
