Motion by Supervisor MacBeth to approve payment of the June 2026 payroll expenses in the amount of \$14,273.26. Second by Supervisor Raybuck. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.

ROAD REPORT:

Work is almost complete on O'Donnell Road using millings and cold patch

Mowed Fisher, O'Donnell, Old 36, water authority, Oakdale, Catholic Church, Blair and Spring Creek

Storm clean up on numerous roads

Put stones on 36 side of building to change the appearance of the township, eventually going to fill and plant something

1. Opening of the sealed bids began at 4:44 p.m.

2. Chairman Greeley announced that the Township received a total of four sealed bids.

3. Chairman Greeley announced that the bid received from Jefferson Paving Corp. would be opened first. The bid from Jefferson Paving Corp. was \$58,421.88 for Item 1. The bid for Item 2 was \$5,872.68.

4. Chairman Greeley announced that the bid received from Russell Standard would be opened next. The bid from Russell Standard was \$71,699.58 for Item 1. The bid for Item 2 was \$7,207.38.

5. Chairman Greeley announced that the bid received from Midland Asphalt Materials Inc would be opened next. The bid from Midland Asphalt Materials was \$69,929.22 for Item 1. The bid for Item 2 was \$17,618.04.

6. Chairman Greeley announced that the bid received from Hager Paving, Inc. would be opened next. The bid from Hage Paving, Inc. was \$64,618.14 for Item 1. The bid for Item 2 was \$6,495.54.

7. Motion by Chairman Greeley to accept the low bid from Jefferson Paving Corp for both Item 1 and Item 2. Second by Supervisor MacBeth. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.

8. **Data Centers Discussion:** Motion by Chairman Greeley to support Brookville Borough's efforts regarding data centers. Second by Supervisor MacBeth. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.

9. **Mill Run Bridge** – There will be a monthly progress meeting on Wednesday, July 22, 2026 at 9:00 via Microsoft Teams.

OTHER SUPERVISOR COMMENTS OR CONCERNS:

1. Supervisors discussed potentially insulating the garage. This issue has been tabled due to financial reasons.
