**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

1. In regards to the proposed Dollar General: The Township was notified by the DEP that they have issued a NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Permit for Discharges of Stormwater Associated with Construction Activities. Construction will commence as weather permits.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. PennDOT District 10 Municipal Services Supervisor, Steve Vasbinder, has provided the township with information regarding the All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) Road Designation Engineering and Traffic Study. Supervisors will review and discuss the information. Motion by Chairman Greeley to make application to designate a portion of Moore Bridge Road, portions of PA-949 and Caldwell Corners Road as ATV accessible road. Second by Supervisor Raybuck. Vote: 2 ayes. Motion carried.

2. An invoice for \$725.00 was sent to R & L Carriers for the tractor trailer recovery performed by the Road Foreman.

3. The Township has signed a Letter of Engagement with the law firm of Ferraro, Kruk & Ferraro, LLP.
4. Townships are required to prepare written procedures in how professional services are chosen for its pension plan(s). Review Resolution 2026-1 Act 44. Motion by Chairman Greeley to adopt Resolution 2026-1 Act 44. Second by Supervisor MacBeth. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.
5. The Supervisors discuss the need for a time clock and decided no action should be taken on this matter.
