UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. In regards to the proposed Dollar General: There is no update on the status since the November 14, 2025 notification by the DEP that they will publish notice of the draft Individual NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Permit for Discharges of Stormwater Associated with Construction Activities in the Pennsylvania Bulletin in the near future. There will be a 30-day public comment period (which may be extended by 15 days at the DEP's discretion). The DEP will consider any comments received and make a decision on whether to issue a final permit.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. The Municipal Pension Plan is being audited for 2020 through 2025.

2. The construction of a 40 x 60 pole building by Eli Mast is complete and the invoice in the amount of \$31,300.00 has been paid.

3. Review bids for electric service to 40 x 60 pole. Motion by Supervisor MacBeth to have bidders resubmit bids for new electric service into 200-amp box. Second by Chairman Greeley. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.

4. Discuss outdoor security light. Monthly charge by United Electric Cooperative is \$15.25.
Motion by Chairman Greeley to retain the outdoor security light. Second by Supervisor MacBeth. Vote: 3 ayes.
Motion carried.

5. The Township received a letter from PennDOT in reference to a petition given to them from a resident. Per that letter:

“Alteration of a traffic control restriction, including additional stop controls or speed limit reductions, must be made based on an Engineering and Traffic Study performed by PennDOT. Requests for an Engineering and Traffic Study should be made in writing and submitted by the local municipality to PennDOT. “

Motion by Chairman Greeley to not submit the above-mentioned request to PennDOT. Second by Supervisor MacBeth. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.

6. In reference to a big rig rescue performed by the Road Foreman, Supervisor MacBeth made a motion to bill the trucking company \$750.00. Second by Chairman Greeley. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.
