**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Discuss Tar & Chipping projects for the year. Equipment rentals. Highest priority roads. Motion by Chairman Greeley to allow the Road Foreman to rent equipment for the purpose of tar & chipping work to be done on O'Donnell, Oakdale, Osborne and Huey Roads. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.

2. The Supervisors and the Road Foreman discussed placing “No Winter Maintenance” signs. Motion by Chairman Greeley to post “No Winter Maintenance” signs on Craft Run, Big Dam, Bottom and Blair Roads. Second by Supervisor Raybuck. Vote: 3 ayes. Motion carried.

3. During an audit of the Pension Fund conducted by the Department of the Auditor General it discovered that in 2021 the PMRS (Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System) Plan was modified to allow in-service distributions. This does not align with the employment policies of the Township. The auditors will meet to discuss this matter.

4. The Greater Jefferson Are Council of Governments (COG) is doing the stone bids. The COG is having a bid opening on March16, 2026. The bids that the COG receives will be given to member townships to accept or reject at their April Regular Meetings. The stone types for Eldred Township are: DSA, #8 limestone, #57 limestone, #3 limestone, 2RC limestone, PA-2A limestone. The COG is also doing bids for oils to be applied. The oil types CRS2 and MC 70.

5. The Supervisors and the Road Foreman discussed policy with regards to the road crew assisting motorists who become stuck in poor weather conditions. In the event of a true emergency the road crew may elect to assist a motorist.
